Your Executive Committee met via Zoom on Tuesday, November 17th and have some information to share with the membership:

Items discussed during the meeting included; Membership Dues, Future of CFC Meetings and events, Scholarships, Calendars, Memorials, and Fish Outs.

Membership Dues: Given the fact that we are unable to hold general meetings due to Covid-19, it was proposed and agreed to by the committee that membership dues paid in 2020 will also cover dues for 2021. Items discussed at the Zoom meeting:

Zoom Programming: CFC meetings currently are not possible due to COVID-19. The intention is to resume regular club activities as soon as feasible. Hopefully as soon as Spring 2021. However, the committee is discussing the possibility of some programming via Zoom. The feasibility of presentations via Zoom will be considered at the next Executive Committee Meeting.

- **Fisheries Advisory Board:** Doug Baldwin, CFC Conservation Chair, has been nominated by the club to serve on the Washington Fisheries Advisory Board. Doug is an excellent candidate for this post and is very willing to serve.
- **Scholarships:** Cliff Swanson shared a copy of the Clearwater Fly Caster's Scholarship Application with the Committee. Based on funds available in the scholarship fund, the club will offer one scholarship at \$1500. Cliff has indicated that he is yet to hear from student advisors concerning Scholarship applications this year, but he expects to receive applications soon.
- Treasurer's Report: Lynn stated that we have \$4,900 in the general fund with \$1,945 in the scholarship fund. He pointed out that the latter was enhanced by the generosity of members who contributed \$700 to the Sylvia Evers and Lillian Young memorial fund. - Calendars: Lynn indicates that several calendars were still available for purchase and that Steve Bush will offer them for sale at his Moscow office this Thursday afternoon, November 19th. Fly of the Month: "The Rusty Nail Chronomid"

Tim Cavalier contributes this fly and says: "Here's your modified Phase 2 Idaho lockdown fly of the month; No need to worry as you sit at your bench in the comfort of your own home and tie flies. Yes, chronomids are used a lot in the spring so you may as well get a jump on them now."

Rusty Nail Fly Pattern Recipe:

Hook: Mustad Signature C49s or similar #10-16

Bead: White brass or tung Underbody: UNI-Stretch Thread: Wine 8/0 70d Rib: Micro tubing,

Bug Legs(FTD), or Super stretch Floss

Body: Mirage tinsel

Overbody: head cement or Bonedry clear (UV resin or similar)
